1 - ZOFELLE (35Δ) - She can be very, very good ON HER DAY. She fires fresh and Gaffalione rode her to victory in Marshua's River at Gulf in January. The **Fastest Closing ZETA Fig (FF1)**.

7 - GOING GLOBAL (28Δ) - Been nothing but sensational vs Grade 1,2,and 3 in Southern California. Prat has rode her 6 times with 5 wins and one close 2nd. She is a player. **TOP Three DELTA** based on the best latest effort. We rated a recent work a **3-STAR-WORK** off our morning observations. Post Position wins less than 10%. Second best **Pace ZETA Fig (F2)**. Third **Fastest Closing ZETA Fig (FF3)**.

6 - BODHICITTA (28Δ) - Chased **GOING TO VEGAS (27Δ)** last out, Desormeaux to ROSARIO. She is battle tested vs Grade 1, 2 and 3. **TOP Three DELTA** based on the best latest effort. **3-STAR-WORK RANKING OUR VERSION OF THE BULLET WORK** off the Work Rankings. Post Position wins less than 10%. Top **Pace ZETA Fig (F1)**.

8 - WARRENS SHOWTIME (37Δ) - Cal bred has been a player in Grade 2 and Grade 3 turf races, she prepped in Cal bred race and boasts a **4-STAR-WORK** off our morning observations. Post Position wins less than 10%.

2 - PRINCESS GRACE (27Δ) - She scratched out of Grade 1, First Lady at Keeneland, but she worked the same morning, 10/9, so she never shipped, possibly the weather concerns had something to do with it, so this was an audible. **TOP Two DELTA** based on the best latest effort. Post Position wins at least 15%.

5 - IPPODAMIAS GIRL (41Δ) - Has 2 wins at Del Mar and last two races were poor, but her Del Mar form at a mile is good. She will be a big price with Saez.

She is a champion, get your crown, congrats, now let us get to fun races to play. **TOP Two DELTA** based on the best latest effort. We rated a recent work a **3-STAR-WORK** off our morning observations. Post Position wins less than 10%. Second best **Pace ZETA Fig (F2)**.

6 - BELLA SOFIA (11Δ) - You don't see Rudy at this level, he has a fast filly. She needs to be at her best here.

4 - CE CE (22Δ) - she is better than the other fillies and should be running on for 2nd. Gamine stubs her toe and she's on deck. **TOP Three DELTA** based on the best latest effort. We rated a recent work a **3-STAR-WORK** off our morning observations. Post Position wins at least 15%. Third **Fastest Closing ZETA Fig (FF3)**.

3 - EDGWAY (22Δ) - Lone 7f try, she chased **FOUR GRACES ((27)Δ)** and ran a good 2nd. She was beaten handily by **GAMINE (19Δ)** in the Great Lady M at Los Al. **TOP Three DELTA** based on the best latest effort. 3rd best **Pace ZETA Fig (F3)**.

9 - KIMARI ((25)A) - Love Kimari here, She has won from 4 1/2 to 7f, the only thing is she needs to break. In 2019 she broke OK, Velazquez was a little nonchalant in the first few strides and soon there after got squeezed and shuffled back, a few strides, the same, and went into the far turn without any momentum and was not handling the turn well, but in the stretch flew, she was tons the best behind the winner **FOUR WHEEL DRIVE ((22t)A)**, who really amounted to little. We need a good trip and seems like Rosario gets her into the fray earlier. If she is dose she wins. **TOP Two DELTA** based on the best latest effort. **4-STAR-WORK** off our morning observations. The **Fastest Closing ZETA Fig** (FF1).

11 - FAST BOAT (26A) - Rosario gets off to ride **KIMARI ((25)A)** and Tyler G gets on, and he won the Troy with a devastating late run at Saratoga, beating **CAROTARI ((22A)** and **GEAR JOCKEY ((25A)**. He is 2 for last 2 at 5f and Sharp has mentioned he is strictly at firm turf horse. He will love Del Mar. **TOP Three DELTA** based on the best latest effort. Third **Fastest Closing ZETA Fig** (FF3).

3 - GOLDEN PAL (35A) - Won't be as easy as beating 2yos, and was less than impressed last out when he had to work to win. He will single for many, great horse to play against. Irad comes back on board. Second best **Pace ZETA Fig** (F2).

12 - EXTRAVAGANT KID (41A) - He is a great EXOTIC horse, 5f is no problem and style allows to settle and move inside for his run from his post. He can be in the EXA and TRI.

5 - ARREST ME RED (31A) - Velazquez rode **GOLDEN PAL (35A)** last out, Irad, who rode **ARREST ME RED (31A)**, is back on 'Pal, and JV back on 'Red. This is the shortest he has gone. We rated a recent work a **3-STAR-WORK** off our morning observations.

10 - GEAR JOCKEY (25A) - I really like this horse but it may be too short, as showed it behind **FAST BOAT (26A)** at 5.5f at Saratoga. **TOP DELTA** for best effort. Second **Fastest Closing ZETA Fig** (FF2).

1 - SILVER STATE (26A) - Throw out the Parx defeat, he had the race won and he decided to pull himself up after he made the lead too soon, he won't have to make the lead too soon and he will need to level off and chase **LIFE IS GOOD (17A)** and **GINOBILI ((22A)**, if the track isn't kind to speed. Watch out **TOP Three DELTA** based on the best latest effort. We rated a recent work a **3-STAR-WORK** off our morning observations. Post Position wins at least 15%.
